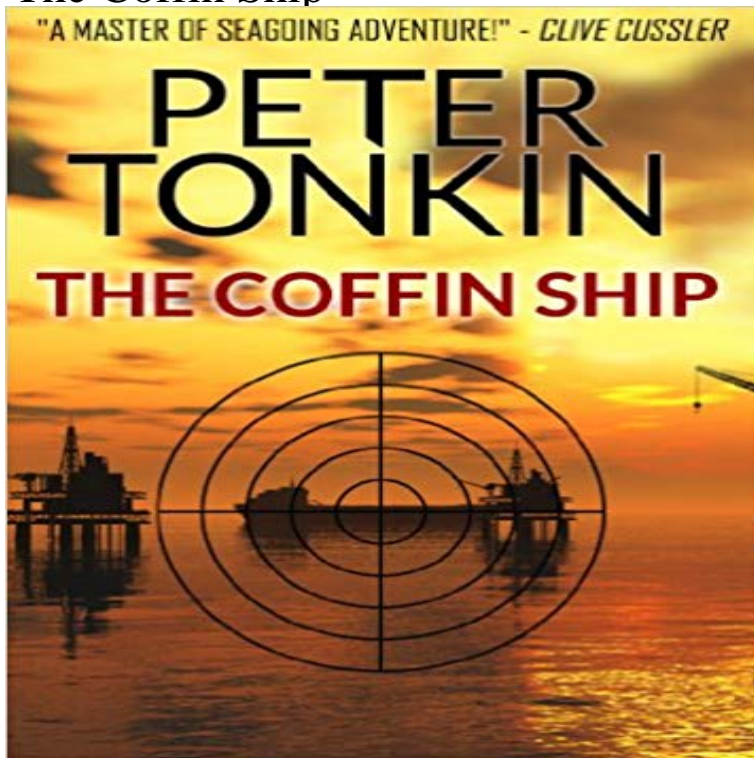


## The Coffin Ship
