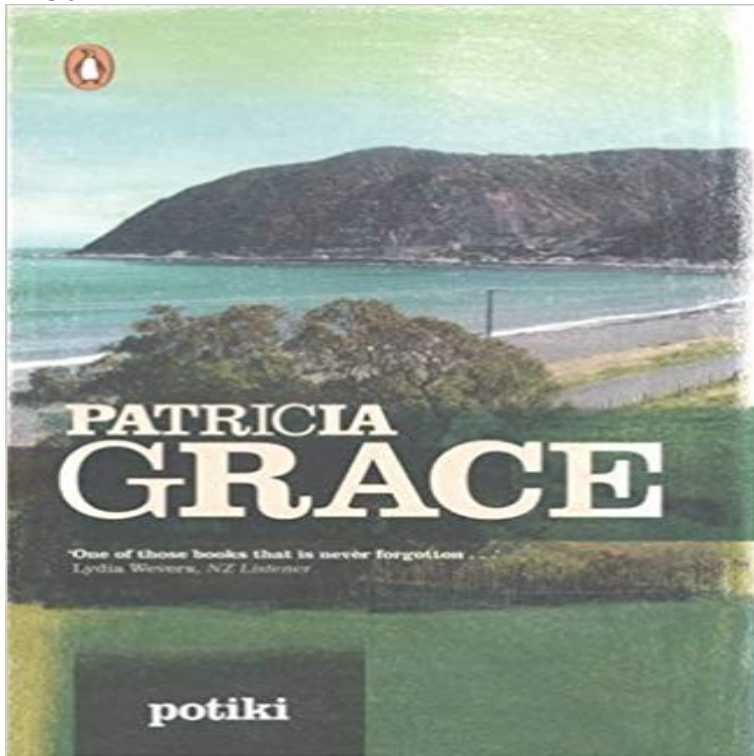


Potiki
