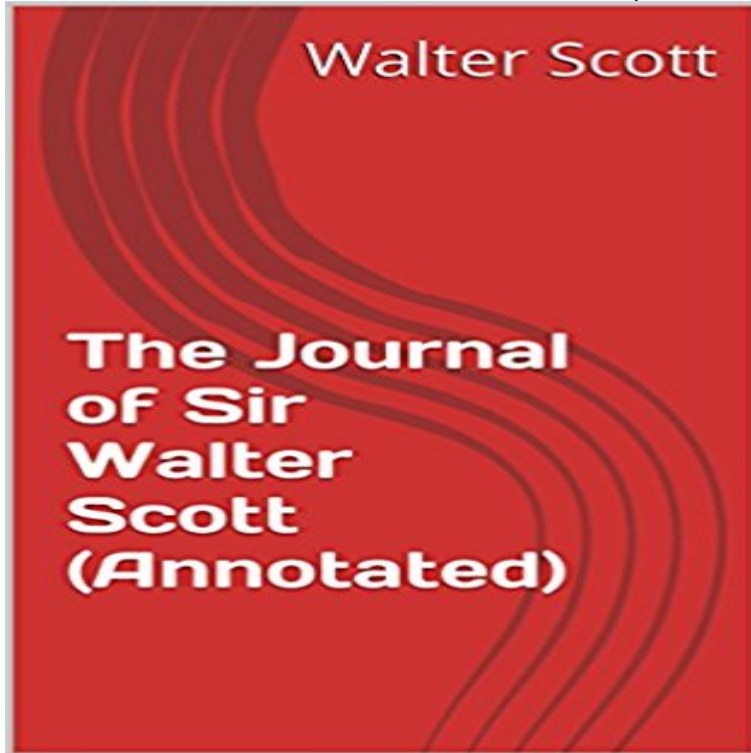


## The Journal of Sir Walter Scott (Annotated)

Since its first complete publication in 1890 it has attracted high praise, being considered by many critics one of the finest diaries in the language.
